

## **What to Bring to Camp...**

- Bible, pens or pencils
- Sleeping bag or bedding and pillow
- Towels and washcloths
- Toiletries – i.e. toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, soap, etc.
- Appropriate clothing (\*Dress Code)
- Light jacket and/or sweatshirt for cool evenings
- Umbrella, rain jacket, or poncho
- Tennis shoes – 2 pair is best, and a pair of flip-flops for showering
- Refillable water bottle or thermos
- Sunscreen
- Insect repellent
- Flashlight
- Pajamas
- Large plastic bag for dirty & wet clothes
- Money for the Snack Shack & Gift Shop\*\* – we recommend between \$15 and \$50
- Some camps have talent shows – bring CD's to sing along with, instruments, or props needed to participate

## **What NOT to Bring to Camp...**

- Personal electronic devices such as iPods, MP3 players, music/video players, personal computers, tablets, or video games
- Alcohol, tobacco, non-prescription drugs or any other illegal substances
- Fireworks, lighters, matches, or weapons of any kind (even toys)
- Water guns, water balloons, or anything used in practical jokes
- Skateboards and Rollerblades are not allowed

\*Dress Code – though we might all have a different view concerning a dress code, we would all agree that some parameters will help us to avoid confusion. Please help us in sending clothing that is in accordance with the code. We ask that shorts and skirts be long enough that when arms are held down to the side, fingertips do not touch skin. Tank tops are permitted during daytime activities, but the straps must be at least three adult finger widths wide. Spaghetti straps, immodest clothing, distasteful messages or designs are not allowed at any time. In general, the dress code is: be smart, be modest, be respectful, and do not cause anyone to stumble!

\*\*Snack Shack & Gift Shop – snacks are for sale one or two times a day from \$.50 - \$3.00 for sodas, candy, pizza, pretzels, nachos or hot dogs. There are also t-shirts, jewelry, posters, stuffed animals, mugs, music, and more for sale. The campers are responsible for their own money. Some parents may need to divide monies into 4 labeled envelopes for the 4 days to help to budget their funds!
